BIOGRAPHY

Leonid Peisahov was born in Tbilisi (Georgia). At the age of 6 he began studying violin at the special school for talented children "Z.Paliashvili"- Tbilisi under the tuition of Prof. L.Jashvili. He had his first solo recital at age of 14.

In 1983 continued his studies at Conservatory "V.Saradzishvili" - Tbilisi, under the tuition of the Prof. K. Vardely. During his studies he performed many recitals as well as also concerts with Georgian Philharmonic Orchestra.

In 1988 he enrolled Master degree studies at the Tbilisi Conservatory under the tuition of the great violinist Oleg Kagan.

From 1989-1991 he worked as assistant-prof at the Conservatory in Tbilisi.He moved in Skopje (R.Macedonia) in 1991 for he had been invited by Macedonian Philharmonic Orchestra. Since then he has been a Concertmaster of the Macedonian Philharmonic Orchestra - Skopje. In a mean time he founded a string quartet, which has successfully performed concerts as well as has realized studio recordings for the Macedonian Radio-Television.

From 1994 he has become a leader of the Chamber Orchestra of the Macedonian Radio-Television. As a soloist and concertmaster he has cooperated with many great conductors as Jansug Kahidze, Veronica Dudarova, Arnold Katc, Juri Aliev, Milen Nachev , Emil Tabakov, Andrey Boreyko and many others. Also he has been announced as a professor of violin at the "Ilia Nikolovsky – Luj College of Music – Skopje. Several of his students have obtained National and international rewards.
